Summer Reading Club for Preschoolers and Children is happening now through July 29. Sign up in the library and start reading!!

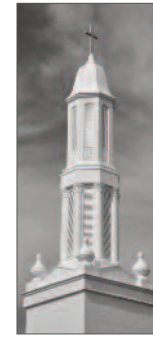
